Girls Group empowers young women to achieve emotional and economic self-sufficiency by ensuring they graduate from high school and begin their college or career journeys.

- Programming spans middle school, high school, and continues through college and careers.
- Participants are mentored by experienced staff and interns.
- Year-round comprehensive programming focuses on academic readiness, social/emotional life skills, financial education, and community service.

COLLEGE & CAREER PREP

The College & Career Prep program provides a diverse range of services to help Girls Group juniors and seniors graduate from high school and prepare for their college and career journeys, many of whom will become first-generation college students. Services include individual and group sessions aimed at creating a college and career mindset. Focuses are:

- SAT/ACT test prep
- Study skills
- High school graduation
- FAFSA support
- Financial planning
- Emotional preparedness
- Scholarship searching
- Essay writing
- College tours
- Job readiness
- Networking workshops
- Girls Group scholarships

The pipeline of Girls Group programming feeds from one core program (Building for the Future) into the other programs. Participants in middle school and high school start in the Building for the Future program. From there, they can access Summer Enrichment programming and College & Career Prep programming. When Building for the Future participants graduate from high school, they enter the Women of Purpose program.

Girls Group honors each participant's individual path towards self-sufficiency. Some participants are interested in beginning their career journey right after high school while others choose to pursue higher education. In the end, there are many ways to achieve emotional and economic self-sufficiency, and Girls Group supports participants as they discover which path is right for them.

COLLEGE & CAREER PREP PARTICIPANTS

The College & Career Prep participants are young women who have previously engaged in Girls Group mentoring services during the school year and summer leading up to their junior year. College & Career Prep participants tend to be intelligent, enthusiastic, and goal-oriented, actively define their goals and dreams, and start new generations of college-bound students in their families.
